The adhesive system is latex-free and hypo-allergenic for broad skin compatibility, supporting users with sensitive skin.

The dressing core features a SupaSorb absorbent pad with a non-adherent contact layer to manage light exudate and reduce trauma

on removal. The breathable, open-weave fabric backing is air-permeable to help reduce moisture build-up under the dressing, while the conforming fit maintains coverage across contoured areas. The robust fabric resists abrasion in demanding environments and maintains adhesion under pressure, helping the plaster stay put for longer wear time.

Designed for reliability across busy settings, the premium construction combines strong adhesion, breathable comfort and skin-friendly materials. The range is suitable for first aid rooms, cabinets and mobile kits where consistent performance and fast application matter.
