## PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

AeroWound Combine Dressings deliver high-capacity wound cushioning and absorbency for situations that demand fast fluid uptake and dependable protection. Built for post-surgical sites, burns and heavily bleeding wounds, the cotton-filled core draws exudate into the pad while the soft loft helps shield the area from further impact. A low-adherent contact surface is designed to minimise sticking at the wound interface, helping to support comfortable changes and continuity of care across clinical, community and first aid settings.

The nonwoven outer wrap provides gentle, low-lint coverage that sits smoothly against skin and under fixation systems. This

construction balances bulk absorption with a comfortable feel, so the dressing can be secured firmly without excessive rigidity. The pad shape sits neatly beneath retention bandages and fixation tapes, helping to create a stable, conforming dressing stack that remains protective during everyday movement.

Each dressing is sterile and intended for single use. The square profile works well as a primary pad over cleaned wounds or as a secondary absorbent layer over contact dressings and topical treatments when additional capacity is needed. Whether responding to a first aid incident, managing post-procedure care, or supporting ongoing wound management, the dressing integrates cleanly into standard workflows and supports reliable outcomes.

Designed for practicality and performance, AeroWound Combine Dressings align with busy environments where simplicity, comfort and consistent absorption matter. From clinics and day theatres to workplace kits and community responders, they offer the reassuring combination of soft cushioning, high absorbency and low-adherent removal that users rely on when treating moderate to heavily exuding wounds.

- **High absorbency:** cotton-filled core manages heavier exudate and helps keep the area cleaner between reviews.
- **Low-adherent contact layer:** supports gentler, lower-trauma removal during scheduled changes.
- **Soft nonwoven wrap:** low-lint cushioning that sits comfortably under tapes and bandages.
- **Sterile, single use:** suitable for aseptic presentation at the point of care.

The **10 × 10 cm** option delivers compact, square coverage with ample absorbency for post-surgical sites and burns, fitting neatly under fixation tapes and bandages for secure retention.

**Quantity:** Single unit supplied for convenient top-ups and point-of-care use, ideal when one highly absorbent dressing is required without opening bulk packs.
