By replenishing key consumables in a single solution, it helps keep onboard medical supplies organised, current, and ready to use when the unexpected happens.

This refill supports a wide range of incidents that can occur in marine environments, from minor cuts and scrapes through to more serious injuries that require interim care until professional assistance is reached. A broad mix of dressings, bandages, tapes, wipes, instruments, and basic response items helps crews respond quickly to common injuries associated with fishing, watersports, maintenance work, and day-to-day life on the water. The layout lends itself to clear organisation within an existing kit so items can be located without delay in rough conditions.

The refill format is particularly helpful for operators managing multiple boats or fleets, as it offers a simple way to standardise kit

contents across different vessels. This promotes consistent first aid coverage whether a person is working on a commercial workboat, skippering a charter vessel, or enjoying time on a family boat. Keeping kits refreshed with a dedicated marine refill also encourages regular safety checks and supports compliance documentation requirements.
