**PRODUCT DESCRIPTION**

The AeroKit Navigator Scale D Marine First Aid Kit is designed to support emergency care on commercial and recreational vessels that need robust, well organised first aid protection. Built around a highly visible, durable case, it helps keep essential first aid items protected in challenging marine conditions. The compact briefcase-style design with carry handle makes it simple to grab in a hurry and easy to stow in cabins, wheelhouses, lockers or bulkhead brackets without wasting valuable space on board.

This kit complies with the Australian NSCV (National Standard for Commercial Vessels) requirements for the indicated class of vessel, giving confidence that it is aligned with recognised marine first aid expectations. It is suitable for use where a comprehensive kit is required to manage a wide range of minor to more serious injuries until professional medical help can be reached. The case dimensions of 42.8 x 30.4 x 14.6 cm provide generous internal capacity to organise dressings, bandages, instruments and essentials while still remaining portable enough to move quickly between locations on the vessel.

The rugged outer case is engineered for marine environments, with materials selected to resist UV exposure and moisture so that the contents remain protected from spray and splashes. A water resistant seal helps shield internal components from the damp, supporting product integrity between inspections. The strong exterior also stands up to the bumps, vibration and movement typical of life at sea, helping the kit remain serviceable over time on working vessels, charters and private boats.

Inside, the Navigator Scale D Marine First Aid Kit is laid out to make locating key items straightforward in stressful situations. A broad mix of dressings, bandages, tapes, swabs, antiseptics, instruments and support items is provided to treat common cuts, grazes, burns, eye injuries and other workplace incidents that can occur on deck, in engine rooms, galleys or passenger areas. Clearly presented reference materials assist users to quickly identify the correct components for each situation so that care can be delivered promptly and confidently.

This kit is well suited to vessel owners, skippers and safety officers who need a reliable solution that aligns with marine regulations and can also serve day to day needs. It is equally practical on commercial fishing boats, workboats, ferries and tourism craft as it is on larger private vessels that travel offshore. The combination of a durable, brightly coloured case and comprehensive contents makes it a strong foundation for marine safety planning and an important addition to any onboard emergency equipment.
