PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

The NAVIGATOR Scale E Marine First Aid Kit is a comprehensive emergency solution designed specifically for commercial and recreational vessels that need dependable first aid capability on board. Built around a robust hard case, it helps protect essential first aid components from harsh marine environments, including exposure to water, sun and salt air. The structured internal layout supports quick access to key items so treatment can start rapidly when incidents occur at sea or while moored.

This kit is configured to support the rapid and initial treatment of common injuries that may occur in marine settings, such as cuts, grazes, minor burns, eye irritations, sprains and strains. It is intended for use in workplaces on the water, including passenger vessels and commercial craft, and also suits larger private boats seeking a higher level of preparedness. The assortment of dressings, bandages, wipes and instruments is arranged to assist with managing bleeding, protecting wounds and supporting immobilisation until further medical help is available.

The case dimensions of 42.8 x 30.4 x 14.6 cm provide generous internal capacity while remaining compact enough to mount in cabins, wheelhouses or equipment rooms without taking up excessive space. A dedicated wall mount bracket keeps the kit secure in rough conditions yet easy to remove in an emergency. The rigid outer shell is UV resistant and has a water resistant seal that helps safeguard the contents against splashes and general moisture in marine environments.

This marine kit is suited to vessel operators seeking to align with Australian NSCV (National Standard for Commercial Vessels) requirements for the indicated class of vessel. It provides confidence that appropriate first aid resources are available for crew and passengers during day-to-day operations and on longer voyages. The kit is ideal for use in the workplace on water, while also being practical for serious recreational users who want a structured, reliable first aid solution instead of assembling loose items themselves.

At home between trips, the NAVIGATOR Scale E Marine First Aid Kit can also serve as a fully featured workplace-grade kit for garages, sheds or household emergency stations. Its clear labelling and organised layout make it simple for different users to locate items quickly, which is particularly helpful in stressful situations. The strong case and practical size also allow it to be moved easily between locations, such as from the vessel to a vehicle or workshop, whenever comprehensive first aid support is required.
