**PRODUCT DESCRIPTION**

The AeroKit NAVIGATOR Scale F Marine First Aid Kit is a comprehensive emergency care solution designed specifically for commercial and recreational vessels that must meet formal marine safety standards. Housed in a robust hard case, it helps keep essential medical supplies organised, protected and ready for rapid access when incidents occur on the water. The bold, high-visibility case stands out in busy cabins and engine rooms, making it easy to locate in low light or rough conditions while its compact footprint fits neatly into wheelhouses, lockers or wall mounts.

This marine first aid kit is engineered for demanding maritime environments. The case construction is UV resistant to help withstand prolonged sun exposure on decks and in wheelhouses, while a water-resistant seal helps protect internal contents from sea spray, rain and high humidity. An integrated wall-mount bracket provides a secure, fixed location on board so the kit can be reached quickly in an emergency, yet removed easily and carried to the casualty when needed.

The Scale F configuration aligns with Australian NSCV National Standard for Commercial Vessels requirements for the specified vessel classes, supporting compliance for operators who must carry a dedicated marine first aid resource. Inside, the kit brings together a carefully curated selection of wound dressings, bandages, tapes, antiseptic products and associated medical items suitable for treating a wide range of common injuries that may occur at sea, including cuts, grazes, minor burns, sprains and other everyday first aid needs. Contents are laid out for quick identification to help save valuable time when responding to an incident.

This kit is ideal for commercial passenger vessels, fishing boats, charter craft and workboats that need a dependable, easy-to-manage first aid solution. It is equally useful on larger private boats where owners want coverage that mirrors professional marine standards. The sturdy carry handle and balanced design make it convenient to move around confined decks, while the rectangular profile allows it to store securely under benches, in cupboards or on dedicated brackets without wasting valuable space. The dimensions of approximately 42.8 x 30.4 x 14.6 cm deliver a generous internal capacity without becoming unwieldy in tight cabins.

Whether used on harbour ferries, coastal cruisers or offshore working vessels, the NAVIGATOR Scale F Marine First Aid Kit supports first response to everyday injuries and unexpected incidents alike. It is a strong foundation for vessel emergency preparedness and a practical addition to safety management plans, complementing other onboard equipment such as lifejackets, fire extinguishers and communication systems while helping crew and passengers feel confident that essential medical supplies are close at hand.
