PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

The AeroKit Navigator Scale G Marine First Aid Kit is designed to support fast, organised care when incidents occur on the water. Built around the requirements of the Australian NSCV (National Standard for Commercial Vessels) for the specified vessel classes, it provides a structured way to respond to common injuries and sudden illnesses while boating. The robust case and clearly arranged contents help crew members and passengers quickly locate what they need, even in demanding marine conditions.

This marine first aid kit is intended for use on commercial and recreational vessels that operate in enclosed and inshore waters. It supports the rapid and initial treatment of injuries in the workplace on board, from minor cuts and grazes through to more serious events that require dressings, bandages, irrigation, protective wear and basic instruments. A comprehensive layout helps make it suitable for mixed-experience crews, giving both trained first aiders and confident lay responders a reliable resource to draw on during an emergency.

The Navigator Scale G Marine First Aid Kit is sized to fit neatly into wheelhouses, galleys or cabin storage areas while still offering generous internal capacity for an extensive range of first aid components. The hard-wearing outer case is suited to marine environments and is shaped for easy carrying between areas of the vessel. A wall-mount bracket allows the kit to be kept in a fixed, highly visible location so that everyone on board knows where to find it when every second counts.

This kit is well suited to vessel operators who need to demonstrate that appropriate first aid provisions are available on board in line with marine guidance. It supports a broad spectrum of situations, from day-to-day boating mishaps through to higher risk activities such as fishing, charter operations and workboat duties. The organised presentation of contents makes replenishment planning straightforward, helping to keep the kit ready for use across busy seasons.

- **Marine ready design:** suited to commercial and recreational vessels that must meet NSCV Scale G requirements.
- **Comprehensive coverage:** supports rapid, initial treatment of a wide range of injuries and incidents at sea.
- **Durable hard case:** tough outer shell and secure closure protect contents in demanding marine environments.

- **Ideal for onboard workplaces:** sized and configured for wheelhouses, galleys and crew areas on working and private boats.

This marine configuration is aligned with NSCV Scale G guidance for the specified vessel classes, making it suitable for operators who need a kit that supports regulatory expectations while remaining practical for day-to-day use on commercial and recreational boats.

Supplied as a single complete kit in a hard case measuring approximately 42.8 x 30.4 x 14.6 cm, this option is ideal for installing in a primary onboard location where it can serve as the main marine first aid resource for crew, passengers and visitors.
