PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

The AeroKit RESPONDER 4 Series First Aid Kit Refill is designed to fully restock a medium workplace or household first aid kit so it is ready for everyday incidents and emergency situations. It brings together a coordinated range of wound care dressings, bandages, tapes, wipes and emergency accessories selected for typical injuries in offices, warehouses, construction sites and busy homes. This

refill is ideal when an existing case or wall cabinet is already installed, allowing fast, efficient replacement of used components without the cost or waste of a new container.

This refill range supports care for common minor injuries such as cuts, grazes, scrapes, blisters and small burns, as well as more serious events where bandaging, immobilisation or eye irrigation may be required until professional help arrives. A mix of adhesive plasters, gauze swabs, combine dressings and non-adherent pads allows users to protect wounds of different sizes, while tapes and conforming bandages help secure dressings in place during daily activity at work, home or on the road. Cleansing wipes and saline ampoules assist with gentle cleaning and irrigation before dressings are applied.

The RESPONDER 4 Series is suited to workplaces supporting approximately 1-25 people in low to medium risk environments and is also popular for home workshops, rental properties, community centres and vehicles. Components are supplied in clearly labelled inner packs, making it easier to identify items quickly and restock individual lines as they are used. The layout shown in the range image helps organisations understand the breadth of protection offered, from disposable gloves and cotton gauze to triangular bandages, tapes and basic instruments such as shears and forceps.

By choosing a dedicated refill, safety managers and householders can simplify compliance with internal policies and external guidelines that call for well-equipped first aid arrangements. It enables a single, convenient purchase to reset all core consumables in an existing RESPONDER 4 Series kit and many comparable designs in the market. This helps maintain confidence that essential first aid supplies are on hand for day-to-day mishaps, workplace incidents, outdoor activities and family travel.
